Folk-rock impressionists trace poignant cross-country journey

After 12 years and five studio albums, Calexico haven't lost any of their fascination with the Southwest, Joey Burns and John Convertino's sonic translations of dust-caked mythologies and hostile sandscapes modernize and polish everyday narratives into glearning vignettes. Mapping out a nameless wanderer's road trip, they return to reverb-y, cinematic songs, with Burns' whispered vocals assisted by guests Sam Beam (fron and Wine) and Douglas McCombs (Tortoise). Bounding from South American political icons to snowy Russian cities, Corried to Dust's songs travel a trall that seems carved out of ancient echoes. IESSICA SUAREZ
